5. Nature of the Emergency – There is an electrical problem (short) in the wiring circuit for the runway 2/20 edge lighting. The temporary fix, resulted in leaving 3 lights inoperable. The edge lights are spaced approximately 200 feet apart, leaving a void of nearly 800 feet Runway edge lights indicate the useable runway to pilots taking off or landing during hours of darkness or inclement weather. There are two safety implication; 1) safe operations for air carrier operations, and 2) possible hazard conditions with surface mounted high voltage wiring exposed to the environment.

8. Description of goods, services, or construction to be purchased
Work to be conducted on a Sunday 12:30am to 8:30am.
1. Saw cut through existing asphalt at least 18" wide, approximately 400'. 2. Excavation and demolition to expose any electrical conduit. 3. Installation of new electrical 2" conduit schedule 40 pvc pipe. 4. Re-pull new electrical wire which is 5KV 8AWG NON/S Type 3. 5. Splicing male and female connector ends which will be connected to the runway light transformer. The connector type is 823KPD4D4. 6. Re-install 2 runway lights and 1 recess light. 7. Pour new concrete jacket up to 2 1/2 inches below existing grade. 8. Apply hot mix asphalt and rolled to meet existing grade surface after concrete cured.

9. Reason for Vendor Selection
Arisumi Brothers., currently has an electrical project occurring at Kahului Airport and has their equipment on site to do the pavement repair work. The Contractor is badged and meets all requirements set by Kahului Airport/FAA to work on the airfield. The Contractor has worked on the airfield at Kahului Airport and is familiar with their procedures and coordination.
