During heavy rains of 12/11/08, major portion of the slope supporting Kunia Rd just north of the entrance to the US Army Field Station. The flood damaged the Army's water line which is located beneath the southbound lane. On 12/12/08, after repairs were made to the line, the water was turned on. A joint along the main waterline leaked causing erosion beneath the southbound lane, forcing the closure of Kunia Road.
