3. Describe in detail the emergency situation that created a threat to life, public health, welfare or safety.
Based on a recent, July 25, 2012, Bridge Inspection Report of the Karsten Thot Bridge, MKE Associates, Structural Engineers sent a letter to informing the Department of Transportation of their critical findings. See attached letter and bridge drawings. A weight limit of only 10 tons for all vehicles travelling on the Karsten Thot Bridge has been imposed and the asphalt pavement was removed from the bridge deck to reduce the load on the bridge.
The Karsten Thot Bridge is a historic steel truss bridge, built in 1932, has severe steel damage and corrosion due to age and years of welding repairs. In 2010 a weight limit of 22 tons for all vehicles travelling on the Karsten Thot Bridge was imposed after a Bridge Inspection Report done by Nagamine, Okawa Engineers. The Karsten Thot Bridge is now rated a Fracture Critical Bridge which means any load above 10 tons could cause this steel bridge to collapse.

6. Describe in detail the emergency goods, services, or construction and explain why it is necessary.
Abhe & Svoboda will provide labor and equipment to remove all lead paint and rust under the deck (substructure) bridge. Then Abhe & Svoboda will have MKE do a follow up fracture critical inspection of the bridge substructure. Based on the findings of MKE, Abhe & Svoboda will replace the corroded/damaged steel gusset plates and install new bolts. Abhe & Svoboda will provide additional structural engineering inspections, environmental consultant for DOH permits, removal of asphalt deck pavement and traffic control.

7. State the reason(s) the vendor/contractor/service provider was selected. Explain what competition, as is practicable, was conducted.
Abhe & Svoboda is a leading contractor in Hawaii that specializes in the repair of steel truss bridges including the safe removal of lead paint. Abhe & Svoboda has worked on other DOT steel bridges through out the Hawaii.


