On Tuesday, October 16, 2012, a section of the Stadium Pedestrian Overpass on Moanalua Road was struck by a trucker hauling an oversize load. The section of the Stadium Pedestrian Overpass that struck was knocked off it's the pier column and wing wall onto Moanalua Road.

6. Describe in detail the emergency goods, services, or construction and explain why it is necessary.
Hawaiian Dredging Construction Company will provide labor and equipment to repair and re-install the damaged section of the Stadium Pedestrian Overpass. The Stadium Pedestrian Overpass is used daily by the Aiea Elementary School children and on the weekends by football fans. On November 5, 2012, Hawaiian Dredging Construction Company completed the repairs and re-installation of the Stadium Pedestrian Overpass.

7. State the reason(s) the vendor/contractor/service provider was selected. Explain what competition, as is practicable, was conducted.
Hawaiian Dredging Construction Company has completed similar repairs on the Aiea Pedestrian Overpass on the H-1 Freeway when a section was severly damaged by the military transporting an oversize load
