Prior efforts were made to replace the system through the competitive sealed bid process, however, only one conditional bid was received on April 29, 2004 from Verizon Hawaii, Inc. DOT resolicited bids, and again received only one conditional bid from Verizon on August 19, 2004. DOT tried to negotiate with Verizon Hawaii, Inc. to procure the repairs through an alternate procurement, but efforts failed to reach an agreement.
