Pursuant to §103D-102(b)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

3. Description of goods, services or construction:
Purchase and installation of MX800 UHF 435-470 MHz Band Repeater Station with all necessary parts, equipment, hardware, software, cables and materials.

The equipment upgrade will also allow the Stadium Authority to remain in compliance with mandatory Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Regulations and guidelines.

8. Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State:
The State Law Enforcement Coalition (SLEC) purchased a Digital 700/800 MHz Band Interoperable Radio Repeater, Antenna and Microwave Dish for the Public Safety Department. The communication equipment was recently purchased through grant funding and installed at the rooftop of the stadium infrastructure by the above noted vendor. The radio equipment is also being currently maintained by the noted vendor. Therefore procurement by competitive means for the purchase of the above noted equipment is not practicable or not advantageous as the State will incur added costs and/or charges should a different vendor be selected.

9. Details of the process or procedures to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure maximum fair and open competition as practicable:
Fair and open competition is not practicable at this time because the noted vendor is familiar and knowledgeable with the existing SLEC system which will integrate/install the new equipment within the existing SLEC radio equipment cabinet located on the upper level concourse of the stadium at no cost. If a different vendor is selected the State will incur added charges for the purchase of a separate radio equipment cabinet, installation, maintenance contract and the possibility of equipment failure, loss of communication and loss of interoperability networking among the other first responder agencies may result in added repair costs.

10. A description of the agency's internal controls and approval requirements for the exempted procurement:
The agencies internal controls, processes and approval requirements for the exempt procurement was followed as required, but is not practicable or not advantageous to the State at this time due to the added charges the state will have to incur.

The equipment purchase will also allow the Stadium Authority to remain in compliance with mandatory Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Regulations and guidelines.
