This amendment to exemption is being sought to continue the existing HATS telephone services contract at the same prices with Verizon Hawaii, Inc. for one year. (See Attachment 2 contract renewal letter offering one-year extension)

This extension of the existing HATS contract is needed to continue telephone service for Hawaii State Government, the Legislature, and the Office of Hawaiian Affairs until a new contract can be awarded.

The current service provider has offered a one year extension at current rates. In comparison, tariff rates are significantly higher than present HATS rates.

This is to inform you that the above referenced contract with Verizon Hawaii will be expiring on November 14, 2004. Verizon Hawaii is pleased to offer the State of Hawaii a one-year extension of the Hawaii Advanced Telecommunications System (HATS) contract (CF-95-022-OHMKL) based on the following:

1. All terms and conditions will remain the same.
2. Verizon will continue to charge the State \$4.95 per month for each Voicemail box assuming that the State maintains a minimum of 5,000 voicemail boxes. Currently, the State has 6,876 voicemail boxes in-service.

The expiration date is fast-approaching. If it is the State's intent to extend the contract, and in agreement with the above pricing and commitment, please have an authorized representative sign below and return this letter by October 22, 2004. This will allow Verizon ample time to complete the necessary paperwork and to document our records by/before the contract expiration date.

Verizon also requests that a Contract Modification extending the contract for a one-year be included with the concurred letter.
