SUBJECT: Request for Exemption

Pursuant to HRS §103D-102(b)(4) and HAR Chapter 3-120, the Department requests a procurement exemption for the following:

1. Describe the goods, services or construction.  
This request is for the purchase of a Hydralift Portable Bridge Access trailer. This equipment was specified to be furnished to the Department through a Highways Division construction project, Project HWY-H-09-99M, Hawaii Belt Road Maintenance Platforms on Various Bridges, and was used by the contractor to install new portable bridge platforms on the various bridges. The contract specified that, following completion of the contract, the equipment be loaned to the Department for a period of three years, and then returned to the contractor. This equipment is essential for installing, adjusting, and removing the portable bridge platforms. The special design allows bridge work where bridge inspection vehicle cannot. The Governor approved our purchase of this equipment on 9/9/11.

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6. Explain in detail, why it is not practicable or not advantageous for the department to procure by competitive means:  
This equipment was furnished to the Department through a construction contract that was let through the public bidding process. The equipment has been used by the Department for its intended purpose for the last 4 years; it is therefore in used condition. It is available at a price that is about 55% of the cost of a new unit. The purchase of this equipment in this manner will afford a significant cost savings to the Department.

7. In selecting the vendor/contractor, explain in detail, the process the department will utilize to maximize fair and open competition:  
The highway construction project that furnished the equipment to the Department was offered through the public bidding process, which assures fair and open competition. The offered price is fair and reasonable for the age and condition of the equipment.
