

STATE OF HAWAII REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM CHAPTER 103D, HRS

Pursuant to § 103D-102(b)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

Description of goods, services, or construction:

Air tools to relocate the Waikiki Yacht Club D-Dock at the Ala Wai F-Dock:

- One gas powered air compressor minimum continuous output 10 CFM
- Two each 1/2" impact wrench (with quick disconnect fittings, Industrial Interchange MIL-C4109)
- Two each 1/2" drill (with quick disconnect fittings, Industrial Interchange MIL-C4109)
- Two each air reciprocating saw (with quick disconnect fittings, Industrial Interchange MIL-C4109)
- One air/water separator (with quick disconnect fittings, Industrial Interchange MIL-C4109)
- One 3or 4 way manifold with quick disconnect fittings (or three "T" with quick disconnect fittings, Industrial Interchange MIL-C4109)
- Four 50' hoses (with quick disconnect fittings, Industrial Interchange MIL-C4109)
- 12 sets of fittings (male and female quick disconnect, Industrial Interchange MIL-C4109)
- Two each 3/4" impact sockets
- Two each 3/4" combination wrench
- Four each 9/16" reduced shank drill bits

We anticipate at least a two to four week wait. The Division will miss the deadline and will be unable to fulfill our commitments to the contractors and the Waikiki Yacht Club if we are not granted an exception.

Details of the process or procedure to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure maximum fair and open competition as practicable:

The procurement was awarded to the lowest bidder.

A description of the agency's internal controls and approval requirements for the exempted procurement:

The equipment will be used for the Waikiki D-Dock relocation at the Ala Wai F-Dock project. The pontoons will be towed from the Waikiki Yacht Club to the Ala Wai F-Dock. The pontoons shall be worked on while they are floating on the water. The purchase of this equipment will help in insuring the safety of our workers. The work will be done at and slightly above the water. The workers will use air tools instead of electric because of the shock hazard for these conditions.

If electric tools were used a power cord would have to be run from the shore to a pontoon floating on the water. The tool would then be used at or slightly above the water line. This is an unacceptable hazard or our employees.

The timely completion of the project is necessary so that the lost of services to our tenants and revenue to the Boating program is minimized.
