A description of the agency's internal controls and approval requirements for the exempted procurement:

The DBOR Engineering staff retained a structural Engineering consultant for the project design. The Consulting Engineer inspected and measured the existing structure before developing the design. The items for bid match the hardware on the existing dock. The use of any other items would require the replacement of the existing hardware. This would increase the cost considerably in labor and material. The use of other materials would mean that the ends of each pontoon section would have to be rebuilt rather than modified and reconfigured. Timely completion of the project is necessary so that the lost of services to our tenants and revenue to the Boating program is minimized.
