Pursuant to § 103D-102(b)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

Description of goods, services, or construction:

- 1). Licensing of the Pontis software. Licensing of the software will allow use of Pontis on an unlimited number of workstations within the D.O.T. and the Counties. Licensing will also allow use of Pontis for Consultants hired to work for the State or Counties. Cost of Licensing = \$30,000
- 2). Purchase of four (4) Service Units. The Service Units are needed for the implementation of Pontis to suit the State's needs. Cost of four Service Units = 4 x \$11,600 = \$46,400.

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Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State:

Procurement by competitive means is neither practicable nor advantageous to the State because AASHTO is the only provider and owner of this software. This annual license renewal is listed as Item 3, Exhibit B. Procurement Approved for Sole Source, HAR 3-122. However, the Association does not provide Certificates of Compliances as required by Act 216.

AASHTO is the only provider and owner of this software.

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FROM CHAPTER 103D, HRS

The Chief Procurement Officer is in the process of reviewing the request from the Department of Transportation for exemption from Chapter 103D, HRS, for the following goods, services, or construction:

- 1). Licensing of the Pontis software. Licensing of the software will allow use of Pontis on an unlimited number of workstations within the D.O.T. and the Counties. Licensing will also allow use of Pontis for Consultants hired to work for the State or Counties. Cost of Licensing = \$30,000. This is an annual licensing fee.
- 2). Purchase of four (4) Service Units. The Service Units are needed for the implementation of Pontis to suit the State's needs. Cost of four Service Units = 4 x \$11,600 = \$46,400. This is a one-time cost needed to have the Pontis Contractor assist the State with the implementation of its Maintenance, Repair and Rehabilitation program of the Pontis Bridge Management System.
