There is no other promoter for this event at this time and place. Bayshore Pacific Group will perform all pre-event planning and Taiwan event production for the tradeshow Gourmet Taipei at Taipei 101, a trade show themed as a Hawaii Experience. The Event's producers will feature and schedule chefs DK Kodama, Hiroshi Fukui and Chuck Furuya and Hawaii entertainers. The Hawaii Pavilion, produced by the event promoters will not be limited to the planning, organizing, and implementation of The Hawaii Experience in Taipei. 9. Details of the process or procedures to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure maximum fair and open competition as practicable:
Bayshore, as the Trade Show promoter is the only entity providing services for the Gourmet-Taipei in Taipei. Procurement by competitive means is impossible as there are no multiple trade shows occurring at the same time, venue and appealing to the same audience. Normally, trade shows do not compete with each other at the identical time and place.

DBEDT staff will provide on-site control, oversight and review of the overall promotion.


