The Contractor shall provide all materials, parts, labor, and necessary equipment for the maintenance, repair (includes complete replacement of totally damaged units caused by vehicular accidents) for all State Highway emergency cellular telephones and their related equipment(s) which includes the computer systems housed at both the Honolulu International Airport Command Center and the H-3 Tunnel Command Center to meet operational requirements and emergency availability.

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Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State:

The service contract project has expired. Due to the addition of newly installed emergency cellular telephones, which requires complex maintenance requirements, the current maintenance specifications has to be revised extensively. The current maintenance specifications are now under a major revision to meet the complex maintenance requirements of the new emergency cellular telephones. It is expected that a new contract will be ready by November 30, 2006.

The vendor who was selected submitted the only quote. Quotations were requested from a total of five (5) prospective service providers. Quotations (SPO Form 10A) were received by the district and attached to this request.


