



Point 6: Scope of work for the contract is revised as follows:

- a. Increase the number of license from 130 to 218 (an increase of 88 licenses.) Increase necessary to facilitate the additional Ask ED operators the neighbor island counties requested and account for potential future increase in Statewide use.
- b. Increase the time of performance of the contract from 85 days to 120 days (an increase of 35 days for quality assurance testing and revision.)
- c. Add a formalized post primary election evaluation / review of AskED with vendor completing desired modifications prior to the General Election (original process was not formalized.)
- d. Add a requirement for the vendor to prevent systems documentation (data dictionary) to allow State to write custom reports (initial proposal was for only user documentation.)
- e. Increase the duration of technical support from a period ending with the 2006 general election to 1 year from the date of contract signing.

Point 7: Reason: This / These amendments(s) are necessary because:

- a. Original number of licenses was sufficient to support the Statewide use of Asked in the 2006 election cycle however after review by operational areas and individual counties, more licenses were required to meet the demand for the application. Business rules and procedures were modified based on the increased value offered by the application.
- b. Expansion of the scope of services was required to assure the State a properly functional deliverable with quality assurance guaranteeing the usefulness of the application in future elections. Adding phases for evaluation, modification, documentation, and training increases the value of the application and its life cycle.
