Pursuant to §103D-102(b)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

3. Description of goods, services or construction:
Provide six (6) specially-trained handlers for six Federal/TSA explosives detection dogs at Honolulu International Airport.

The specialized services cannot be placed out for bidding. TSA has the program information Classified "Confidential" Security-Sensitive.

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8. Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable nor advantageous to the State:
The specialized services cannot be placed out for bidding. TSA has the program information Classified "Confidential" Security-Sensitive.

The time frame requested for this exemption is to allow for transition preparation and Securitas Security Services USA to complete is presents Airports' Bid Contract for Security Services..

9. Details of the process or procedures to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure maximum fair and open competition as practicable:

After the regular bidding process for Security Services for the Airports has been Awarded, the K-9 Program would normally move to that company for continuity of service. The terms of the administrative support and management of the K-9 Program is negotiated with that Awardee. During the most recent Security Company change, there was a question raised concerning the ownership of the new company by a Federal Agency. Having setteled that, we are now in the process of the transition to the new Security Company listed above. This transition requires some time and a contract must be executed for the company to get prepared under the FAA/TSA rules. Therefore, a continuation of the present handling company's exemption is necessary while this Securitas Security Services USA exemption will also be in effect. Then the old will close.

10. A description of the agency's internal controls and approval requirements for the exempted procurement:
Ultimately, the terms and conditions of the Negotiated Contract are under the direction of the TSA, the Airports' Security Manager, the Operations Branch, the Procurement Supervisor and the Deputy Director of Airports.
