

NOTICE OF AND REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION  
FROM CHAPTER 103D, HRS**

1. TO: Chief Procurement Officer

Pursuant to §103D-102(b)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

3. Description of goods, services or construction:  
Conduct a site survey, install new Forum ALERT Plus System, test and commission the system, de-commission the old 711 Emergency & Secondary Crash Net System, conduct training, provide a one year warranty. The new Forum ALERT Plus System allows for successful alerts, communication connections to ramp controller to interconnect to aircraft rescue and firefighters, medical, sheriff, security, and key operations and maintenance personnel. The Forum ALERT Plus system will ensure that the Honolulu International Airport Emergency 711 System and Secondary Crash Net inoperability meets operational readiness in accordance with 14 Code of Federal Regulation Part 139.319

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8. Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable nor advantageous to the State:  
In accordance with 103D, HDOT-A staff planned, budgeted, prepared bid specifications, and advertised this project. We received only one bid with conditions and unacceptable to HDOT-A contracts. The service provider alleged specifications were flawed and didn't submit a bid. We have no knowledge whether they couldn't meet the specification or their assumption was correct. In the aftermath of October 15, 2006 earthquake struck which impacted HNL's complete electrical power source, emergency communications and telephones line became inoperable from system failure thus Air Traffic Control Tower communications to HNL and secondary response system became inoperable. The system is inclusive of alerting all first responder. The urgent replacement of this system is necessitated to ensure readiness and the safety of traveling public

9. Details of the process or procedures to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure maximum fair and open competition as practicable:  
SDV Telecommunications, Inc. is the most knowledgeable on the Honolulu International Airport's operations and internal workings of the 711 system and Secondary Crash Networks. They're also the service contractor for the communications system and would be the best candidate to ensure that all of the critical components are addressed and implemented at the Honolulu International Airport. SDV Telecommunication's in-house knowledge of existing problems coupled with their daily working maintenance with the existing , stakeholder's requirements, network function and understanding of inoperability will reduce the installation time without impacting first responder's alert protocol. SDV Telecommunications has an identical system installed at Wheeler AFB which as a similar airfield layout and communication infrastructure as HNL.

10. A description of the agency's internal controls and approval requirements for the exempted procurement:  
 HDOT-A follows exempt procurement protocols. The subject procurement will be coordinated in accordance with internal procurement procedures and guidance. The goods and services including installation and project acceptance will be monitored and evaluated by Ms. Annette Knell, Project Manager/Acting Unit Supervisor.



REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM CHAPTER 103D, HRS (Cont.)

Chief Procurement Officer's comments:

This procurement exemption request is disapproved. Based on this procurement exemption request and the additional information provided, it is apparent that the department now has at least \$125,000 for the replacement of the subject communications system. In follow-up to the initial solicitation, the department should correct the bid specifications and reissue the solicitation as a new solicitation and procure the communication system through a competitive procurement process. However, should the DOT determine that the current communication system's failure is imminent; the emergency procurement process in accordance with HRS section 103D-307 may be utilized.
