Pursuant to §103D-102(b)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

3. Description of goods, services or construction:  
The joint effort between HCJDC, GovCore Solutions and SEARCH Group to develop a Global Justice Reference Architecture (JRA) Proof of Concept (POC) in response to a National Institute of Justice (NIJ) grant opportunity using Hawaii's criminal history record information system (CJIS-Hawaii) and its next generation Integrated Justice Information System (IJIS), as the pilot. The JRA would be tailored to Hawaii's needs through a series of user requirements gathering sessions, the result of which would be a documented architecture that can serve as the foundation for information sharing amongst criminal justice agencies in Hawaii. A possible consideration would be to pilot a statewide warrants system for Hawaii's criminal justice community using this information sharing architecture. The JRA architecture that is developed would be implemented through a combination of Hawaii's resources, listed in Exhibit A, and software developed by GovCore as part of this POC. The developed software would consist of open source software that is aimed at providing a cost effective way to implement the pilot as well as enabling us to inexpensively extend the POC to other criminal justice agencies.

8. Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable nor advantageous to the State:  
This contract is a result of being chosen to be a POC state based on a proposal submitted by GovCore to NIJ. Hawaii has no funding for such a pilot and being chosen to partner with GovCore and SEARCH in this NIJ grant, is a great opportunity for Hawaii's criminal justice community. Hawaii's contributions are in-kind staffing and already-procured strategic and wants/warrants consulting services. NIJ has approved funding for GovCore Solutions POC. Because of Hawaii's unique environment of cooperation amongst Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice agencies and HCJDC's ongoing strategic planning efforts, HCJDC was approached to be used as a POC, possibly using the statewide wants/warrants as the application. A condition of the NIJ grant is that GovCore partners with Hawaii.

### Manpower

- Participation of a consultant previously engaged by Hawaii for a strategic planning project in the process of developing a customized JRA for Hawaii
- Technical staff resources to assist GovCore and its partners with the integration of the software and hardware required for the POC
- Participation of our consultant and development funds for a statewide wants and warrants system

### Financial

- License fees for the commercial software required to establish a test bed for the POC acquired by the Hawaii State Computing Center and according to state licensing agreements
- Travel subsidies to allow our partner criminal agencies on the neighbor islands to participate in the develop of the JRA for Hawaii and evaluation of the completed POC

### Equipment (purchased according to state procurement code)

- Server hardware for installation and testing at identified POC sites
- A server to be used as the ESB platform for the POC
- Workstation(s) for client access to the application during the POC

### Other

- Participation of HCJDC staff in the development of a customized JRA for the State of Hawaii and the GJXDM sub-schema to be used for the POC
- Coordination with the Information and Communications Services Division (ICSD) of the Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS) for networking and other resources that may be needed
