Pursuant to §103D-102(b)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-120, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

3. Description of goods, services or construction:

Act 212, SLH 2007, provides for the Governor to appoint eight individuals to serve on an aha kiole advisory committee whose task it will be to: identify models that an aha moku or regional council system could be based; develop a system of best practices for natural resources management based upon native Hawaiian traditional knowledge and practices; obtain feedback from moku statewide on the development of an aha moku council system and a commission to oversee the system; develop an administrative structure for this system, establish eligibility criteria for aha kiole members and an executive director; conduct strategic planning relative to a commission's goals and objectives; and to establish an operational budget for the commission. The vendor will provide the necessary services (coordination between committee members, organize, schedule, and support travel for district, island, statewide meetings, analysis of public input and related information, report writing, etc.) to the committee to fulfill the Act's identified tasks (stipulated above).

8. Explanation describing how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable nor advantageous to the State:

The activities leading up to the enactment of Act 212, SLH 2007 involved primarily native Hawaiians. Conferences or puwalu were held in the previous year by native Hawaiians, their organizations, and affiliates, to set the groundwork for S.B. 1853 (later to become the Act 212). The specified vendor had participated and in fact played a key role in these conferences' organization, participated in them, and has been a key organizing party to the entire process. The specified vendor has unique knowledge of the background for the aha kiole advisory committee's tasks, has participated in the formulation of those tasks, and has been nominated by the aha kiole advisory committee to coordinate this group's work. Knowledge of the Hawaiian language, culture and practices, key participation in the puwalu conferences, and liaison with the key stakeholder groups qualify this vendor over others and adds value to ensuring a successful completion of the Act's provisions.

9. Details of the process or procedures to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure maximum fair and open competition as practicable:

Vendor selection is already determined with the support of the aha kiole advisory committee; please see Section 8 for the explanation.
