5. Description of goods, services, or construction:
The Department of the Attorney General, on behalf of the Department of Health ("DOH"), requires the following legal services from Janice Futa of Hisaka Yoshida & Cosgrove. Ms. Futa shall represent the Director of Health as Movant in Conditional Release applications for the Hawaii State Hospital ("HSH") forensic patients pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") section 704-412; Motions for Findings and Fitness to Proceed to trial pursuant to section 704-406, HRS; Motions for Authorizations for Release on Conditions While Still Unfit; ~~Motions for Involuntary Medication; and Motions for Authorized Absence pursuant to section 334-75, HRS.~~

6. Scope of work for the contract is revised as follows:
Scope of work was not revised. Contractor is paid on an hourly rate at \$165.00/per hour. The exemption in the amount of \$150,000 was approved by the Chief Procurement Officer on December 5, 2007. The contract was executed in the amount of \$180,000 on May 22, 2008. We are requesting that the exemption amount be amended and increased from \$150,000 to \$180,000.

Initially, it was believed that \$150,000 would be sufficient to cover the contract services, however, before contract execution it was determined that an additional \$30,000 would be necessary to cover all the services under the contract. At this time, it is estimated that \$180,000 is sufficient to cover all the services under the contract.
