	Provision of standby and call back psychiatric services for the Kona Community Hospital. The provider will participate, on a rotational basis, with other State employed psychiatrists on the standby roster.

Describe how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State:	Procurement by competitive means is not advantageous to the State because the scarcity of psychiatrists in West Hawaii has resulted in the inability to produce any other individuals interested in participating in the standby roster. Procurement by competitive means is also not advantageous because the rates to be paid for the services have already been set. A Request for Proposal (RFP) will be issued by the end of September 2007 and it will take approximately three months to evaluate proposals, negotiate contracts, and execute contracts.

Describe the reason for the selection of the provider including a description of how the procedure ensured the maximum fair and open competition practicable:	Other West Hawaii psychiatrists were asked if they were interested in participating on the standby roster and no other psychiatrist expressed any interest.
