Pursuant to § 103F-101(a)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-141, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

1.	Title and description of health and human service(s):	
	The Department of Human Services seeks to provide services to TANF or TAONF eligible clients in Hilo in order to assist them in obtaining paid employment. Services to be provided may include, but are not limited to, screening, intake and orientation, job/work activity readiness, job/work activity coaching, job/work activity placement, job/work activity retention, on-going case management, and support services delivery such as child care, transportation and work-related expenses, to assist TANF and TAONF eligible clients with finding and retaining employment.

6.	Describe how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State: Goodwill Industries of Hawaii was awarded the contract for the Grant Diversion program under competitive procurement RFP HMS-903-04-11-EH. The contract ended on September 30, 2008. There are no further extensions. PEH 09-01 was submitted requesting Goodwill Industries be allowed to continue servicing clients in Hilo until the UFUE services could be procured. Based on a recent Federal program instruction, the Grant Diversion program would not continue after September 30, 2008. Clients would be serviced under a new program, Upfront Universal Engagement (UFUE). Adoption of the administrative rules for UFUE was expected by October, 2008 and services for UFUE procured effective January, 2009. Adoption of the administrative rules has been delayed until February, 2009. A RFP will be issued in January to procure services effective July 1, 2009. Therefore, it is requested Goodwill Industries continue servicing clients in Hilo until June 30, 2009.	
7.	Describe the reason for the selection of the provider including a description of how the procedure ensured the maximum fair and open competition practicable: Goodwill Industries of Hawaii is the current service provider of the Grant Diversion program in Hilo. Goodwill has the infrastructure and the program knowledge necessary to continue providing uninterrupted service to clients.
