

2. Title and description of health and human service(s):	One-on-one support: additional service required to reduce the youth's inappropriate and unsafe behavior and actions.

4. Total Contract Funds:	12,937.50 7 1/2 hours daily @ \$15 ph

Crisis purchases of service are limited to current needs only. Enter justification for length of contract: Based on youth's behavior the CAMHD Family Guidance Center and BBC feel at least four months of one on one support would improve the youth's behavior to the point he would no longer be a risk or disturbance to himself and others in the program.		
6. Describe the nature of the crisis condition (pursuant to section 3-147-201, HAR):	This youth, minor C.L.S. CR# 321498, was assigned to Bobby Benson Center (BBC) to address some serious drug abuse issues; however, while in program he began to display additional dangerous and threatening behavior. He was temporarily removed due to a questionable assault charge, and BBC did not want to take him back without additional support to preclude the threatening behavior. BBC was concerned with the safety of other clients and possible hostile reactions from peers towards the youth.t.  CAMHD agreed to one on one support to get him back into the program for treatment and to help BBC assure safety of their program for all youth. He re-entered their program on 7/8/09.	

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7. Describe the reason for selection of the provider (including description of practicable competition): Since July 1, 2006, Bobby Benson Center has been CAMHD's existing provider of Community Based Residential Level III services specializing in drug abuse and mental health issues involving youth drug abuse.	
8. For approvals requested after-the-fact, explain why it was not practicable to request approval prior to the purchase: Client was already assigned to BBC when the additional behavior problems begin to manifest themselves and the Provider working with the Family Guidance center determined the inappropriate behavior could be resolved and other patient's safety insured with the additional one on one support.
