Pursuant to § 103F-101(a)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-141, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

1. Title and description of health and human service(s): Ancillary Support Services for CAMHD clients.		
Ancillary support services are provided to clients who are not stabilized and need additional services beyond what is offered at the residential treatment programs. The ancillary services may include one on one services, partial hospitalization and/or other special services recommended to meet the client's special needs on the short term, until the client is stabilized and can proceed with the standard residential treatment.

6. Describe how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State:		
The CAMHD has awarded residential based services to Benchmark Behavioral Health Services, Bobby Benson Center, Catholic Charities Hawaii, Child and Family Service, Hale Kipa, Inc., Hale Opio Kauai, Inc., Hawaii Behavioral Health, LLC., Kids Behavioral Health of Hawaii, Inc., Marimed Foundation for IHCT, Maui Youth and Family Services, Sutter Pacific, and The Queen's Medical Center following the HRS 103F competitive procurement procedure. However, in exceptional cases, some clients require ancillary services which are not covered in the current contract, in addition to the residential program services. These ancillary services must be provided within the existing residential contracts. The ancillary services would be provided to "high-end" clients as a structured alternative in addition to the standard residential services provided. Ancillary services are provided based on documented clinical justification from the client's clinical team. Due to the variable and short term structure it is not feasible or practicable to procure such services outside of the residential contracts.		
7. Describe the reason for the selection of the provider including a description of how the procedure ensured the maximum fair and open competition practicable:		
The request is for CAMHD to be able to provide ancillary services within all the current residential contracts. Ancillary services are provided to clients who are already receiving educational services, family therapy, and integrated service planning within a residential program but needs additional services beyond the skilled milieu of residential programs. Ancillary Services will become an intergal part of all future residential service contracts procured by CAMHD.		

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8. Describe the state agency's internal controls and approval requirements for the exempted procurement: The CAMHD Administrator provides overall oversight of the CAMHD clinical services. The CAMHD Medical Director, in particular, will provide clinical oversight and will review the medical necessity and appropriateness of client's continued use of ancillary services while at the residential treatment program. Furthermore, the CAMHD clinical team and the treatment team from the provider agency will meet regularly to monitor client's progress and evaluate the effectiveness of this short term clinical intervention.
