2. Title and description of health and human service(s):	A terminal patient under hospice care became increasingly restless and would not follow direction regarding not getting out of bed unassisted. The patient's safety became a concern as he required someone at his bedside at all times to prevent fall injuries.

5. Term of Contract:	Start: 5/10	End: 5/17 2012
Crisis purchases of service are limited to current needs only. Enter justification for length of contract: Terminal patient required constant observation at night to avoid personal injury. The patient passed away on 5/17/12		
6. Describe the nature of the crisis condition (pursuant to section 3-147-201, HAR):	A terminal patient under hospice care became increasingly restless in the last days of his life. He was getting in and out of bed without waiting for assistance despite frequent reminders. The medications he was on for pain relief could cause dizziness and walking with an unstable gait. Both of these situations had the potential to enhance the patient's fall risk. The patient's increasing restlessness could not be anticipated and the need for services became urgent not allowing for following the normal procurement timetable. The Health Division currently does not have a contract to provide this level of nursing care. The Department is evaluating adding this level of service in our nursing contract when they go back out to bid.	

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7. Describe the reason for selection of the provider (including description of practicable competition):
Na Kahu Malama Nurses has been able to meet last minute requests for nursing assistants. They have nursing assistants who have worked in a prison environment in the past.


8. For approvals requested after-the-fact, explain why it was not practicable to request approval prior to the purchase:
