Pursuant to § 103F-101(a)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-141, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

1.	Title and description of health and human service(s): Acute and continuing psychiatric inpatient care including twenty-four (24) hour supervised care in a secured unit with direct psychiatric care. Acute services require ongoing monitoring of consumers' mental status, stabilization interventions, and rehabilitation or return to the community as necessary.
2.	Provider Name and Address: Sutter Health Hawaii dba Kahi Mohala 91-2301 Fort Weaver Road Ewa Beach, Hawaii 96706
3.	Total Contract Funds: \$26,400,000 (estimated) Contract Funds per Year (if applicable): \$13,200,000
4.	Reference number of Previous Request for this Service (if applicable): PEH No. 13-30
5.	Term of Contract: Start: 7/01/15 End: 6/30/17
6.	Describe how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State: Procurement by competitive means continues to not be practicable because of the need to comply with a permanent injunction. The permanent injunction requires the Director of Health to take custody of certain categories of individuals within 24 or 48 hours. These individuals would be placed in either Hawaii State Hospital (HSH) or another appropriate facility including a general medical/surgical hospital with psychiatric inpatient service or a psychiatric hospital. Without these services, individuals court ordered to the custody of the Director of Health may be placed in imminent harm or may place the public in imminent harm. Procurement by competitive means will also not be advantageous to the State because the Adult Mental Health Division (AMHD) proposes to continue to contract with all providers of psychiatric inpatient services. There continues to be only three hospitals on Oahu that provide psychiatric inpatient services: Sutter Health Pacific dba Kahi Mohala, Castle Medical Center, and The Queen's Medical Center (QMC). The QMC is not interested in providing services for AMHD.
7.	Describe the reason for the selection of the provider including a description of how the procedure ensured the maximum fair and open competition practicable: The selected provider is one of two hospitals on Oahu with psychiatric inpatient services interested in providing services for AMHD. AMHD is proposing to procure services from these hospitals in order to comply with the permanent injunction.


