Responses to Question Raised by Applicants
FOR RFP No. PSD 14-CPSE-64, EMPLOYMENT SERVICES FOR INMATES AT THE
WAIAWA CORRECTIONAL FACILITY ON THE ISLAND OF OAHU

Question No. 1: What is the planned time frame for internet ready computer use at Waiawa?

Response No. 1: The planned time frame for internet ready computer use at Waiawa is upon execution of contract and availability of requested services.

Question No. 2: Will external drives be allowed to store resumes, cover letters, mock applications, etc., especially if internet access is not available?

Response No. 2: If internet access is not available, external drives approved and screened by the department may be allowed.

Question No. 3: What is the estimated time inmates have in GP at Waiawa before going to OCCC or Laumaka?

Response No. 3: Inmate transfers to OCCC, or Laumaka, from Waiawa varies and are based on their security classification, program readiness, and availability of bedspace.

Question No. 4: Will some inmates go directly to Parole or Max from Waiawa. If so, how many do you estimate?

Response No. 4: Yes, very few inmates may parole or complete their maximum sentence at WCF, but it is too difficult for the department to provide an estimate because Parole and Max decisions are made by the Hawaii Paroling Authority.
