The following Questions and Responses are hereby provided and incorporated into this RFP:

Section 2 Service Specifications, 2.5 Compensation and Method of Payment

1. How is the Department of Education planning to address the minimum wage increase over the next four years for the A+ Program?

Response: The Office of Curriculum, Instruction and Student Support (OCISS) is analyzing the projected A+ Program costs for school years 2015 through 2018. Multiple factors are being examined, including but not limited to, costs related to the A+ Program administration, private providers, school providers and operational costs.

2. How is the 9 month payment plan established?

Response: The 9 month payment plan is based on the school calendar. According to the 2015-2016 school year calendar, there are 180 student days. Since there are approximately 20 student days per month, when the days are divided, the total comes out to 9 months (180 days/20 days = 9 months).

3. How will accommodation requests be addressed?

Response: Requests for accommodations, for students who require assistance to access the A+ Program, are evaluated on a case-by-case basis. If the request is approved, an A+ aide is provided to assist with the accommodation needs.
