Section 30.330 QUEST-ACE		Add the following sentence to the end of the first paragraph: <u>“QUEST-ACE coverage will begin effective February 1, 2007.”</u>
Section 30.510 Positive Enrollment Period for Existing Members	First paragraph reads as follows: From November 2, 2006 through December 31, 2006, all individuals who are existing members of health plans will be required to select a health plan. This sixty (60) day period is hereby referred to as the positive enrollment period for existing members. All enrollments which occur during this period will be effective on February 1, 2007.”	First paragraph is amended as follows: From <u>January 2, 2007</u> through <u>February 28, 2007</u> , all individuals who are existing members of health plans will be required to select a health plan. This sixty (60) day period is hereby referred to as the positive enrollment period for existing members. All enrollments which occur during this period will be effective on <u>April 1, 2007.</u> ”
Section 30.550 90-Day Grace Period	First sentence in the first paragraph reads as follows: The DHS will allow existing members to change health plans without cause for the first ninety (90) days (February 1, 2007 – May 2, 2007) from the effective date of positive enrollment in the health plan regardless of whether enrollment is a result of selection or auto-assignment.	First sentence in the first paragraph is amended as follows: The DHS will allow existing members to change health plans without cause for the first ninety (90) days (<u>April 1, 2007 – June 30, 2007</u>) from the effective date of positive enrollment in the health plan regardless of whether enrollment is a result of selection or auto-assignment.
