

**QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS
from HTH 440-8-4 Orientation
Held October 6, 2006**

During the Orientation for HTH 440-8-4, the following question was raised.

Question:

If the federal grant prohibits campaign contributions with funds from the federal grant, can state funds be used for such purposes, or vice versa?

Answer:

The federal grant prohibits the use of grand funds to make campaign contributions. Likewise, Section 11.205.5 Hawaii Revised Statutes disallows the use of funds appropriated by the state legislature for campaign contributions during the term of the contract. In case the contract has mixed funding (both federal and state) both federal and state laws apply, with the more stringent law taking precedence.
