**ADDITIONAL RFP QUESTION AND ANSWERS
July 17, 2007**

The following are the responses to the written questions that were submitted prior to the midnight deadline of June 29, 2007, but were omitted from the Questions and Answers dated July 13, 2007, for RFP HTH 440-1-16, Community-Based Adolescent Outpatient Substance Abuse Treatment Services.

Q. 6. On page 2-9 A 1(a) Intensive Outpatient treatment. The RFP states “usually operates for at least three (3) or more hours per day for up to five (5) days per week”. Is this a required configuration of time or is there an opportunity to propose a different distribution of time?

A. As referenced in the Treatment Improvement Protocol (TIP) Series 4, the intensive outpatient level of care requires a minimum of nine (9) hours of service per week. Anything less than 9 hours per week would be considered outpatient treatment. Generally, it is preferred that treatment be offered in 3-hour blocks of time per day.

Q. 7. Is there a minimum number of hours of service that must be provided at the intensive outpatient level of treatment?

A. Addendum #1 was issued on July 13, 2007. On page 2 an addendum to Page 2-18 of the RFP was made to III. Scope of Work, 9. Unit of service and unit rate, a) 2. which states that “the rate shall be ONE-HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$120) per day which shall include a minimum of three (3) hours per day face-to-face individual, group, and/or family sessions”. As stated in the previous question (Q.6), the minimum hours of service per week for the intensive outpatient level of treatment is 9 hours.
