1. Question: Clarify the probable funding for this project.

Response: *Refer to amendment section that follows for page 2-2, Section 2.I.F
and page 2-4, Section 2.II.E.*

RFP No.: PSD 09-CPS/PB-01, Family Therapy and Counseling Services for the Bridge Program on Oahu is amended as follows:

Subsection Page

Section 2, Service Specifications

I.F 2-2 The funding available for the initial contract period is \$48,000 (\$32,000.00 for male offenders and \$16,000.00 for female offenders). The initial contract period shall be from April 1, 2009 to September 30, 2009. Subject to the availability of funding beyond June 30, 2009, the resultant contract may be extended for three additional twelve month periods or portions thereof at an estimated available funding of \$96,000.00 per year (\$64,000.00 for male offenders and \$32,000.00 for female offenders.)

II.E 2-4 Initial Term of Contract shall be for the six month period commencing on April 1, 2009 and ending on September 30, 2009.

Length of each extension: Twelve months or portions thereof.

Number of possible extensions: Three (3), upon prior mutual agreement in writing and subject to the availability of funds beyond June 30, 2009.

Maximum length of contract: Forty-Two (42) months.
