RFP No.: PSD 09-HPA-44, **Supportive Living for High Needs Female Parolees on Oahu** is amended as follows:

Section 2, Service Specifications

Subsection Page

II.A.	2-4	“Applicant will be required to accept parolees who have been assessed by the HPA as being appropriate for services, unless the Applicant presents to the HPA, justifiable reason that a parolee should not be accepted into the program. The Applicant shall provide only those [treatment] services identified by the Department/HPA as required for the parolee....”
III.A.	2-6	Paragraph remains unchanged. Reference to “treatment and recovery programs” are for referrals to “outside” treatment and recovery programs.
III.B.4	2-8	Bullets 4, 5, and 6: refer to parolees referred to a treatment program (whether provided by the applicant or through an outside vendor). No changes required.
III.B.6	2-9	Paragraph 2, last sentence, “community-based treatment programs” remains as this is an activity that the applicant must demonstrate an ability to coordinate with other activities required by the scope of services.
III.B.7	2-9	“Treatment” services refer to the services provided either in-house or referred to an outside provider.
III.B10	2-10	Paragraph 1, 1 st sentence, Delete “treatment”.
