Pursuant to HRS §103D-306 and HAR chapter 3-122, Subchapter 9, the Department requests sole source approval to purchase the following:

1. Describe the goods, services, or construction to be procured.
The Department of Health's Neurotrauma Supports program is purchasing Hawaii Health Information Corporation annual membership to allow 2 neurotrauma staff to obtain (stroke, spinal cord injury, and traumatic brain injury) data encompassing hospital and emergency department admissions/discharges. Individual, de-identified data will allow the neurotrauma program to gain a better understanding of Hawaii's incident rate of neurotrauma injuries and staff to improve the system of supports of individuals with neurotrauma and their families. Examples of data fields include: type of injury, age, sex, location of residence, length of stay, cost of treatment(s), cause of injury, etc.

6. Describe in detail the following:
a. The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction.
Hawaii Health Information Corporation (HHIC) is the only health care information organization that currently collects, analyzes and produces reports on discharge data from hospitals statewide; therefore, it is impractical to attempt to contract with another entity to engage in a similar type of activity. Hospitals would be very reluctant to establish new agreements and fiscal arrangements with another entity to replicate what is being done by HHIC.
b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department
The data obtained from HHIC enables the neurotrauma program to plan, develop, and coordinate supports for individuals with neurotrauma injuries.

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction.

The HHIC is the only entity in the State that has formal agreements with hospitals statewide to obtain hospital admission and emergency data. It would not be in the best interest of the state, department, division, and branch to have the program try and establish agreements with each hospital statewide to provide data to the program as the program does not have an IT infrastructure in place to collect and analyze the data of 5,000 records on an annual basis.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

The HHIC is the only entity in the State that obtains hospital admission and emergency department data from hospitals statewide.



HHIC as Sole Source

1. Unique features, characteristics, or capabilities
 - a. HHIC is the only organization that collects, edits and enables access to Hawaii's hospital discharge (inpatient) and emergency department data.
 - b. HHIC's business is the collection, analysis, and dissemination of statewide health information. HHIC is the only organization in the state with a focus entirely on health data.
 - c. HHIC has sixteen years of successful data warehousing experience.
 - d. HHIC staff knowledge includes Hawaii's healthcare market, local and national data suppliers, public health, benchmarking, analysis, data quality, analytic tools, databases and websites. HHIC staff is available to work with DOH staff to develop a larger pool of knowledgeable workers to apply Hawaii's hospital data for public health purposes.
 - e. HHIC is a neutral, fair broker of information.
2. Alternate source. There are not alternate sources for acute hospital inpatient data (1995-present) and emergency department data (2000-present).
