Pursuant to §103D-306, HRS, and Subchapter 9, Chapter 3-122, HAR, the Department requests sole source approval to purchase the following:

Description of goods, services, or construction:

The Maui County Prosecuting Attorney uses a case management software package called JustWare to monitor and control the cases that are referred to its office. The JustWare Case Management System is currently not sending offender information to either the juvenile or the adult offender tracking systems for the State of Hawaii. Modifications will be required to the existing JustWare System to exchange information with the state's Juvenile Justice Information System (JJIS) and Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS). Through an interface, the State's systems will receive information about the prosecutor's charge disposition and any additional add-on charges. The JustWare System must be modified to receive and store the statewide ID for an individual. The ID can be used by the prosecutor to look up information in the statewide system for offenses outside of Maui County. This request is to purchase the agency interface to allow this bi-directional data sharing. By rule adopted under Section 846D-2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Dept of the Attorney General is responsible for funding the interface.

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The goods, services, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities:

The JustWare Case Management System is proprietary software and modifications must be compatible with future vendor releases and covered under the product's warranty. This service is unique because the vendor is the only one who can change the software without invalidating the warranty of the software. Since modifications within the vendor's actual software are required to accommodate a compatible interface with the JJIS and CJIS and since these changes will need to be tested for all subsequent upgrades and changes to the vendors software, only New Dawn Technologies will be able to implement the necessary software changes and ensure future compatibility.

Also, the proposed interface will utilize the Global Justice XML Data Model (GJXDM). The vendor is one of six industry representatives helping to define the technical design of what prosecutors will utilize to exchange data with those criminal justice agencies that want to take advantage of the GJXDM. The federal government has adopted GJXDM as the standard for all justice agencies.

REQUEST FOR SOLE SOURCE (Cont.)

How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities are essential for the agency to accomplish its work:


The ability to electronically exchange information between the JustWare Case Management System and the JJIS or CJIS is essential because there exists no alternative besides hiring staff to do manual data entry. Manual data entry is an unacceptable alternative because it is untimely, error prone and over the long run, extremely costly. The cost will also be continually recurring until an interface is developed. Timeliness is essential in that it achieves accurate data that facilitates proper decision-making. Conversely, untimely data entry produces erroneous data that may result in incorrect decisions that hurt the offender and the community. New Dawn is uniquely qualified to make these changes since they designed and wrote the system needing modification.

The following other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction were investigated but do not meet our needs because:

We considered other methods of procurement but this is the only solution that will allow the Maui Prosecutor to maintain their case management system under warranty with the vendor.


