**Description of goods, services, or Construction purchased:**

Upgrade of the Hawaii Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) to the next generation AFIS, called MetaMorpho.

**Purpose for extension and reason(s) why it is not practical to award another contract at the time of extension:**

The State's AFIS was originally installed in 1990, and subsequently upgraded to XL 3.1 in 1999. The current AFIS has served the law enforcement community well, but is in need of upgrading its aging technology to keep pace with the demands of public safety and Homeland Security for more timely and accurate positive identification of offenders.

Due to programming, customization, and software certification delays on the part of Sagem Morpho, Inc. (SMI), the vendor, the entire system will not be installed and tested until the first quarter of 2006. Additionally, the Lights-out Transaction Controller (LOTC) which is the central component responsible for coordinating all the different systems in the Lights-out environment is the responsibility of the HCJDC. This component is in the procurement/construction phase and will not be available prior to expiration of the initial contract. MetaMorpho cannot operate as a stand-alone AFIS; it must have the LOTC for operational purposes.

The upgrade would be provided by Sagem Morpho, Inc. which is the vendor for the current AFIS system. The primary funding source for the upgrade will come from the Bureau of Justice Assistance's \$1.8 million Congressional Earmark for FY2003. We expect the full integration of CJIS-Hawaii, MetaMorpho AFIS, LOTC and all other associated components to be in place during first quarter of 2006.
