Feature: The good, service, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities: Security Resources is the only company in the State of Hawaii , which is certified by the Manufacturers (Verint, and Identocard) to repair and service the integrated security equipment in our system, i.e the Verint (Loronix) digital video recorders, the Identocard Passport viewing platform and interfaces, and associated miscellaneous video equipment.

9. Essential features. How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities are essential for the agency to accomplish its work: The Integrated Security system is utilized to protect and monitor Harbor activity as part of an overall Homeland Security protection system. The system is designed to provide monitoring capabilities on a 24/7 basis for the Harbor Police, and other law enforcement agencies in overall efforts to prevent and respond to emergency situations. The integrated system is essential to the protection of the ports, it's users, employees and assets. The system is vital to the anti-terrorism efforts and homeland security initiatives. For the safety of the general public, our employees, harbor users and the State of Hawaii it is vital to keep the Integrated Security System operational 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

 Board of Water Supply(BWS) currently has a sole source maintenance contract with said company for their security cameras.
