How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities are essential for the agency to accomplish its work: Pacific Wireless Communications is the only supplier of shelf ready Motorola communication equipment in Hawaii that is essential to insure uninterrupted medical communications between emergency ambulance units, 911 ambulance dispatch centers and hospital emergency department physicians statewide.

The following other possible sources for the good, service, or construction were investigated but do not meet our needs because: Three (3) radio communications providers were contacted (Bear Com, CQ Communications and Delta Communications) to see if they have the capacity to provide statewide service and maintenance services on the State Department of Health's MEDICOM radio/microwave system. All stated that they did not have the personnel resources, system expertise or on-site facilities to provide the services necessary for normal and emergency response services for the 9-1-1 MEDICOM system.
