

Marquis ID Systems captures and stores the demographic data and images (photograph, signature, fingerprints) for each applicant applying for a Hawaii State Identification (SID) card on a server. This system has the capacity to store unlimited data/images captured for each applicant providing the ability to track each time an applicant has received a SID card. Furthermore, this system provides for the capability to search fingerprints captured for each applicant against its data base so that any attempt to apply for and receive a SID card under another name would be found therefore, eliminating the possibility for identity theft or an underage applicant attempting to be 21 years or older to enter establishments in which proof of age is required to be served liquor.

Fixing and cleaning up problematic database records and improving the identity theft prevention features are essential to maintaining the integrity of the SID system. Furthermore, the system will allow applications to be completed on-line and sent via the State's web portal. Another important factor is the Real ID Act 2005 in which Congress mandated that States must meet minimum document requirements and issuance standards by May, 11, 2008, or risk having the State's driver's license or identification card not recognized by any federal agency or airports. In order to comply with these new demands on the SIS, program changes must occur to the system. Part of these new changes includes sharing information with other State's DL/ID programs and law enforcement personnel. We need to work with the vendor to allow an easy transfer of our information to these other agencies.
