 Impres Multi-Unit Charger - 1 unit @ \$707.18 + freight @ \$35.36
 Lithium Ion Batteries - 13 units @ 403.85 per unit + freight @ \$115.44
 Motorola Astro XTL 5000 Digital Mobile Radio - 1 unit @ \$5,744.00

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8. Feature: The good, service, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities:

(1) These radios will be used on the Department of Public Safety (DPS), Sheriff's Division (SD) Land Mobile Radio (LMR) system and will be interoperable with the Honolulu International Airport 800 Mhz Trunk, Kalaeloa Airport 800 Mhz Trunk, Oahu Highways 800 Mhz Multicast, Oahu Harbors 800 Mhz Conventional, Lihue Airport 800 Mhz Trunk and Kauai Highways 800 Mhz Trunk radio systems.

(2) These radios are Project 25 (also known as P25; an International initiative that established common public-safety digital radio communications standards for first/emergency responders) compliant. Eventually, all U.S. first responders are mandated by federal directives to use P25 standard radios.

(3) The Motorola radios have an Advanced Digital Privacy (ADP) software encryption that prevents unauthorized reception of transmissions.

(4) The Motorola radios are 700/800 Mhz convertible and are able to receive text messaging.

9. Essential features. How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities are essential for the agency to accomplish its work:

These radios will provide reliable interoperable Project 25 standard based radio communications between the Department of the Attorney General, other member agencies of the State Law Enforcement Coalition (SLEC - members are Attorney General - Investigations Division, Sheriff's Division, DLNR -Conservation & Enforcement Division, and Department of Transportation - Harbor's Police), and other state agencies. Radio communication is key to protecting the lives of law enforcement officers and citizens and is essential when responding to terrorist incidents or natural disasters. Furthermore, these radios will be capable of migrating from 800 Mhz to the 700 Mhz band when the Sheriff's trunking radio system becomes available.

11. Alternate source. The following other possible sources for the good, service, or construction were investigated but do not meet our needs because:

- (1) PWC was given the construction award and solely-designated in Hawaii by Motorola to build the Sheriff's Division LMR system that includes their trunk system, dispatch consoles, repeater stations & radios.
- (2) No other vendor has the equipment and technical capability to integrate these radios into DOT's 800 Mhz radio infrastructure (Airports, Highways and Harbor Police) with the SD's radio system.
- (3) PWC has service facilities and resident technicians on all four of the major Hawaiian islands to perform immediate radio repair in the event of a state-wide or neighbor island specific emergency.
- (4) PWC is the only Motorola-Authorized Service Center in the State of Hawaii.


