Attachment to Notice of Amendment To Sole Source Contract

The 800 MHz portable repeater package which is being considered will provide extended radio coverage in areas where coverage is found to be marginal or unavailable. The portable repeater will work off of a portable solar/battery source and programmed with designated state-wide mutual aid channels (per approval by State Telecom). Existing Attorney General radios equipped with these mutual aid channels will have the ability to establish enhanced, on-site communications and/or establish connectivity with the SLEC (or appropriate county radio) network by way of this 800 MHz portable repeater system. The portable repeater system will receive and relay voice calls over a predetermined mutual aid channel, to the AG's Command vehicle/trailer (situated within a coverage area), and via the ACU-M, cross connect calls to the SLEC (or appropriate county) radio system.

The 800 MHz portable repeater system is completely transportable and readily deployable on all islands. However, in that same regard, it is important to note that there may be instances whereby the repeater may require re-tuning (due to the established frequency spread), reprogrammed or serviced to effectively operate off of the designated mutual aid channels that are called for on each island. As a result, it is important that the selected radio provider be required to have its own service centers available statewide on each island to perform time critical support/remedial work during a disaster, emergency response or enforcement activity. As a statewide provider, with presence on four major islands, Pacific Wireless Communications is able to provide support with on-island service techs and facilities.
