# STATE PROCUREMENT OFFICE NOTICE & REQUEST FOR SOLE SOURCE

Pursuant to §103D-306, HRS, and Subchapter 9, Chapter 3-122, HAR, the Department requests sole source approval to purchase the following:

Description of goods, services, or construction:          The services and hardware being furnished to the Sheriff, Dept. of Public Safety involves the delivery of a Motorola 700 MHz two way radio system, a Telex IP-based communications interoperability system, VOIP and computers with satellite broadband connectivity to the Sheriff's Mobile Command Trailer. The Sheriff's Motorola 700 MHz two way radio system will connect and control UHF, VHF, 800MHz, Conventional, Trunked, P25, iDEN, PSTN systems and other communications platforms with the Telex IP-based dispatch console via Satellite. The computers will allow broadband access to various data bases such as NCIC and Warrants and additionally provide video feeds to requesting agencies. The Sheriff's Mobile Command Trailer will require antennas to be installed on the Sheriff's Mobile Command Trailer. All antenna systems will require on island EME certified technicians to mitigate any harmful electromagnetic emissions. Attached is a copy of proposed equipment and the services that will be rendered.</p>

Feature: The good, service, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities: Pacific Wireless Communications, LLC. is the only authorized provider in the State of Hawaii that presently has a C-15 Hawaii Electronic System Contractors License. Pacific Wireless is also the only certified service center that is qualified to provide Electro Magnetic Emission certification for fixed radio antenna installations. Pacific Wireless is the only authorized Warranty Center for all Motorola subscriber and fixed radio equipment which is currently being used by the Department of Public Safety/Sheriff's Division. The vendor has more than 100 employees and factory trained technicians on all the islands with the latest test equipment and extensive inventory of OEM parts and spares, allowing needed repair and support services to be deployed in support of the MCP during an emergency minimizing response time 24/7, 365 days of the year, anywhere in the State of Hawaii.</p>	
<p>9. Essential features. How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities are essential for the agency to accomplish its work: The Public Safety Department (PSD) – Sheriff Division (SD) is the lead agency in the State Law Enforcement Coalition (SLEC) and is tasked with supporting and coordinating all state law enforcement response and recovery assets in the event of a natural disaster, WMD, Homeland Security or Mass Casualty event. The Telex IP-based communications interoperability system, and computer network in the SD Mobile Command Center (MCP) will provide the State government the resources and ability to communicate and run operations for an extended period of time in the event that all land base communications were to be unavailable. During emergencies, the system will provide connectivity via the Satellite network. The MCP will provide the connectivity to Federal, State, County and Correctional communications/data system statewide. The vendor will ensure that all voice, data, and video sources will be seamlessly integrated into the SLEC/PSD - Sheriff Division Motorola 700MHz, P25 Public Safety Interoperable Communications system for statewide response.</p>	

11. Alternate source. The following other possible sources for the good, service, or construction were investigated but do not meet our needs because: Pacific Wireless Communications, LLC, is the only licensed contractor in Hawaii that is staffed with a minimum of 5 local certified radio and data certified CCNA and MCSE engineers to address any radio engineering and data interface requirements to the Satellite network. With the extensive mission critical system being provided to first responders for use during an emergency, it is imperative that all software and programming parameters are fully integrated and work cohesively across the data spectrum, to include voice over internet protocol (VOIP), radio over internet protocol (ROIP), SAT feeds, video streaming as well as on VHF/UHF/800MHz/700MHz Interoperable Radio Systems statewide.


