8. Feature: The good, service, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities:  
The integrated security system utilizes Verint (formerly known as Loronix) digital video recorders (DVRs) as part of the closed circuit television monitoring solution. There is only one vendor in the State of Hawaii who is a Verint Certified System Integrator, SimplexGrinnell.

9. Essential features. How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities are essential for the agency to accomplish its work:  
The existing integrated security system is utilized to protect and monitor harbor activity as part of an overall Homeland Security protection system. This system is designed to provide monitoring capabilities on a 24/7 basis for the Harbor Police, and other law enforcement agencies, in an overall effort to prevent and respond to emergency situations. The integrated system is essential to the protection of the ports, its users, employees and assets. The system is vital to the anti-terrorism efforts and Homeland Security initiatives. For the safety of the general public, our employees, harbor users and the State of Hawaii, it is vital to keep this integrated security system operational 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

11. Alternate source. The following other possible sources for the good, service, or construction were investigated but do not meet our needs because:

In Sept07, we contacted Verint to inquire about other vendors in the State that are authorized to support their equipment. Security Resources, Inc, Pacific Wireless Communications (PWC) and SimplexGrinnell were provided as contacts. In Oct07, Verint terminated it's Integrator Distribution Agreement with Security Resources effective immediately. PWC certifications have lapsed and they are no longer an authorized Verint system integrator. SimplexGrinnell is the only Verint certified system integrator company in the State of Hawaii who is allowed to repair and maintain Verint equipment.


