3. Description of goods, services, or construction:
Product: Instant Road Repair is a rapid curing asphaltic concrete mixture used by Department of Transportation maintenance crews for asphalt pothole patching.

8. Feature: The good, service, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities: The patching material comes in ready to use 3 and 5 gal resealable buckets. Which makes it both cost effective and easy to use. Crews are able to permanently patch potholes just by pouring out from the container. There are no additional primers or bonding agents to add. It can be applied without special equipment or skilled personnel. It can be used on potholes regardless of weather conditions. It remains stable in an unconfined area, it is a rapid curing product and will not shrink after it cures. It is also long lasting. There is no need for constant repairs to the same areas.

9. Essential features. How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities are essential for the agency to accomplish its work: Crews can keep buckets in their trucks while working on roadways to do spot pothole repairs. There is no need for heavy dump trucks, mixing equipment and multiple workers to shovel and compact patching material. This material is ready to use, does not require mixing or additives. Crews are able to work faster because preparation time is reduced, the area to be patched does not have to be primed with sealant or a bonding agent. All they have to do is open the container pour the mix into the pothole and let it set, no compaction required.

Crews can respond to pothole complaints immediately because the product can be stored at the various Baseyards around the island. As long as the container is properly sealed the material can be stored up to a year. With the amount of complaints this department receives regarding potholes, this product is a time saving and cost effective way to deal with the one of the many challenges this department faces in keeping our roadways maintained.

11. Alternate source. The following other possible sources for the good, service, or construction were investigated but do not meet our needs because: The current procedure of using black plumeria asphalt to fix potholes has not been effective. The hot mix has to be prepared, several heavy duty trucks must be utilized, multiple crews have to shovel and compact the mixture before it hardens, and police are needed to control the rolling lane closure, and the material does not last. The asphalt is not easy to store and must follow EPA guidelines for containment
The Maintenance Crews have also tried other products such as QPM and Wespro, however these products did not perform as desired. QPM was not adhering to the asphalt. Westpro's mixture separates while in storage and must be remixed creating more work for the maintenance crews.


16. Chief Procurement Officer's comments:
