3. Description of goods, services, or construction:
Contract 24-hour repair and maintenance services for Hawaii's statewide Medical Communication (MEDICOM) emergency communication system. The UHF/VHF land mobile and microwave communication system consists mainly of Motorola equipment and system design technology. Provide quarterly routine service, maintenance and repair to the emergency backup generators located at remote sites on the islands of Kauai, Maui and Hawaii.

Feature: The good, service, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities: Pacific Wireless Communications is the only authorized provider of maintenance and repair for Motorola equipment with factory trained technicians on the islands of Kauai, Oahu, Maui and Hawaii to provide 24-hour radio and microwave communication repair and maintenance (attached letter from Motorola dated February 23, 2010).


