Pursuant to HRS §103D-306 and HAR Chapter 3-122, Subchapter 9, the Department requests sole source approval to purchase the following:

3. Description of goods, services, or construction:  
 Modified New England Traffic Monitoring System (NE TMS) software that provides a comprehensive environment for requesting, loading, validating, analyzing, reporting, and managing all forms of traffic data. HDOT-Highways Planning has migrated the database from Oracle 9 to an Oracle 10 environment. Work will involve changes to the software necessary to be compatible with the updated database. The work will be done under two purchase orders. The first purchase order will include investigation and a proposed solution. The second purchase order will involve implementation of the solution. See attachment for the scope of work in each purchase order.

8. Feature: The good, service, or construction has the following unique features, characteristics, or capabilities: GIS/Trans originally developed the NE TMS software for 7 transportation agencies (Maryland, Vermont, New Hampshire, Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island). Approval of Sole Source No. 03-69-R allowed the HDOT-Highways Division to join this consortium of seven Transportation Agencies by adopting their NE TMS software. Additionally, the original sole source was later amended since the approved vendor, GIS/Trans, Ltd. was bought out by bd Systems, Inc. (Sole Source No. 03-69-M). bd Systems, Inc. which became Science Application International Corp. (SAIC) further customized the software for Hawaii's needs (Sole Source No. 08-034-C). The database design and components of the NE TMS software are now unique to Hawaii.

9. Essential features. How the unique features, characteristics, or capabilities are essential for the agency to accomplish its work:  
 Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 500 Subpart B- Traffic Monitoring System (TMS) mandates that each State, develop, establish, and implement on a continuing basis, a TMS to be used for highway traffic data. To implement and maintain a traffic data collection, information, dissemination, and reporting program that ensures compliance with the requirements of 23 CFR 500B, seven transportation agencies (Maryland, Vermont, New Hampshire, Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, and Rhode Island) and FHWA have invested nearly \$2 Million into the operational New England (NE) TMS software. The Highways Division of the Hawaii State DOT has invested an additional \$293,334. The information generated by the TMS is in turn utilized to help determine each state's annual fair share apportionment of the Federal Highway Trust Fund Monies.

11. Alternate source. The following other possible sources for the good, service, or construction were investigated but do not meet our needs because: SAIC (fka bd Systems, Inc. and GIS/Trans, Ltd), was the same contractor who developed the customized NE TMS for the State as well as the seven original Transportation Agencies and as such the contractor is the only reasonable party that can make the modifications and/or enhancements in both a timely and cost efficient manner.




