Pursuant to HRS §103D-306 and HAR chapter 3-122, Subchapter 9, the Department requests sole source approval to purchase the following:

1. Describe the goods, services, or construction to be procured.
Twenty-two (22) units of Harris ProVoice 7250 dual band 700/800 Mhz multimode portable radios with support equipment. Price quote is attached.

6. Describe in detail the following:

a. The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction.
The Sheriff Division's Executive Protection Unit (EPU) needs the ability to communicate on multiple radio communications systems managed by various agencies to maximize their ability to protect the Governor and Lt. Governor for the State of Hawaii. Their ability to communicate on the Honolulu Police Department's Enhanced Digital Access Communications system (EDACS) manufactured by M/A - COM is essential for this detail. Only radios manufactured by Harris have the capability to communicate on the EDACS system.

b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department to accomplish its work.
EPU needs to have the ability to communicate on the EDACS in order to communicate effectively with HPD. This radio has the capability to utilize multiple systems of communication. Again, only radios manufactured by Harris have the ability to use the EDACS which HPD currently uses. The radio requested has the capability to also communicate with other Sheriff Division 1st responders and is critical during a mutual response event or support request. This equipment will also allow the EPU to utilize the State Shared Blended (SSB) system as well. Providing no less than 3 capable communications systems to this unit will greatly enhance their communications capability.

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction.

The Sheriff Division has worked with the HPD radio section to determine that only Harris Communications equipment can operate on the EDACS. Previous contact also with the local vendor for Motorola also confirms the lack of ability for Motorola equipment to be used on the EDACS as well. Dailey-Wells is the local authorized dealer in Hawaii for Harris communications equipment and provides systems and sales support for the equipment on the EDACS.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

According to the memo attached dated August 20, 2009 by the Harris Corporation to the City and County of Honolulu, only Dailey-Wells is the sole authorized Harris Corporation Network Solutions Provider (NSP) in the state. The EDACS system falls into this category and thus is supported in this state by Dailey-Wells Communications. The Sheriff Division has also communicated with the HPD radio section which has confirmed that the EDACS system will only work with Harris Communications equipment. Communications with Dailey-Wells confirms that they are the only source of support of equipment that utilizes the EDACS in the state
