National Core Indicators (NCI) is a collaborative effort between the National Association of State Directors of Developmental Disabilities Services (NASDDDS) and the Human Services Research Institute (HSRI).
b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department
Data collected by the state and analyzed by HSRI will compare Hawaii with the 27 other participating states on the mainland in the areas on self-determination, health and safety, choice, control, etc. Information to be used by the state to assess and improve services for recipients of DD services.

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7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction.

There are no other nationally recognized organization in the field of developmental disabilities that has developed survey instruments to assess states' performance on standardized benchmarks and compare results against other participating states.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

The DOH-DDD could have developed its own survey instruments; however, it would be at a much greater cost due to the need to insure the validity and reliability of that data obtained. This procurement is in the best interest to the state as the HSRI engages in continuous quality improvement activities to ensure survey questions and data are valid and reliable.


