Pursuant to § 103F-101(a)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-141, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

1.	Title and description of health and human service(s): Mental Health Services in out-of-state facilities.	
	The Department of Health's Child and Adolescent Mental Health Division (CAMHD) is responsible to "provide prevention, diagnostic, treatment and rehabilitative services for emotionally disturbed and mentally ill children and youth" through the age of 20 years; and the coordination of mental health services for youth adjudicated through the courts. (§321-171 HRS; IDEA 20 U.S.C. § 1401; Section 504)

6.	Describe how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State: At times the CAMHD must provide authorized services through out-of-state providers. The need to place a youth in an out-of state facility occurs only after all efforts to meet the youth's treatment need in Hawaii have been exhausted; the youth is in need of specialized treatment that is not locally available; or the determination for placement is reflected in the youth's Individualized Education Program (IEP) or court order. The ability to anticipate, develop, and adequately meet all procurement requirements for each youth in need of such services in a timely manner is not practicable and would place the State at risk of violating federal law and/or court order. Further, any delay of clinically necessary services would not be in the best interest of the youth or the state.	
7.	Describe the reason for the selection of the provider including a description of how the procedure ensured the maximum fair and open competition practicable: The multi-disciplinary treatment team and the established Individualized Educational Program process and/or a court order shall assess local programs to determine appropriateness of placement and to ensure competition. Only after local programs are deemed inappropriate, a mainland facility is considered.	

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8. Describe the state agency's internal controls and approval requirements for the exempted procurement: The CAMHD has implemented a process for the payment of out-of-state facilities. Payment shall be processed only upon the approval by the CAMHD Family Guidance Center involved and with a valid Service Authorization for the invoiced period. The CAMHD Accountant reviews and resolves deviations to the process. The CAMHD strives to have a contract in place that reflects the Individualized Education Plan, and includes the negotiated reimbursement rate and manages the rate increases.


NOTICE
