
Pursuant to § 103F-101(a)(4), HRS, and Chapter 3-141, HAR, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

1. Title and description of health and human service(s): Provide comprehensive training and support services for inmates and formerly incarcerated persons to assist them in their successful reintegration into the community.

Describe how procurement by competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the State: §3-144-302 (a)(3) , HAR: Only one provider satisfies limitations imposed by the source of funds for the procurement. Act 8, of Special Session 2007, (SB932,SD2, HD2,CD1), page 34, Part V, Section 16 through page 37, Section 17, describes services for inmate reintegration into the community, and directs the department to enter into a purchase of services contract with the Maui Economic Opportunity, Inc. for the development and maintenance of inmate reintegration programs. (Refer to attached copy of Act 8 Special Session 2007.) Also refer to Deputy Attorney General's determination dated April 15, 2008 regarding the procurement action as a restrictive purchase of service.

Describe the reason for the selection of the provider including a description of how the procedure ensured the maximum fair and open competition practicable: Not applicable, Act 8, Special Session 2007 imposes the restriction of a specific provider.
