Section 2, Service Specifications

2.6.1 2-2

Question No. 1: Under section 2 "Service Specifications", paragraph 2.6 "Service Activities", page 2-2 it states, "Service provider shall provide dental services at a minimum of two (2) days a month to inmates at the following facilities on the island of Hawaii." Does the State of Hawaii anticipate the need for additional days of services? If so, what is the maximum number of days of services a month?

Response No. 1: It is anticipated that dental clinics would occur every other week which averages out to two times per month. There may be months that depending on how the days fall, would require 3 clinics to occur within a single month. It is our belief that as long as the vendor provides 8 hours of service every other week there would be no need to go beyond 26 clinic days per year.
